X. SITE FURNISHINGS GUIDELINES

A. General Site Furnishings Requirements

The site furnishings design philosophy of the Project is to create an aesthetically attractive and cohesive use of site furnishings that:

- unifies the Project through the use of similarly styled site furnishings, and
- encourages simple, understated parks and open spaces featuring seating areas, benches, bike racks, trash receptacles, kiosks, gazebos and trellises for the comfort and enjoyment of residents, visitors and patrons of the Project.

In order to promote a unified image for the Project, the following site furnishings guidelines apply to parcels.

B. Parcel Site Furnishings

FP-1 Parcel Benches, Bike Racks, Trash Receptacles, Etc.

Benches, bike racks, trash receptacles, water fountains, and similar types of site furnishings will complement the Lowcountry architectural theme of the Project. Cast concrete and molded plastic-resin or fiberglass type furnishings of



modern style and bright colors are not allowed at the Project.

Playgrounds attached as accessory uses to restaurants, convenience stores, and other retail-commercial businesses are not allowed at the Project.

FP-2 Parcel Bollards

Pedestrian or vehicular bollards will comply with the Lowcountry architectural theme of the Project. Internally lighted bollards will have louvers or a translucent lenses to reduce glare.

FP-3 Reserved

FP-4 Parcel Kiosks, Gazebos, Trellises

Kiosks, gazebos and trellises will complement the Lowcountry architectural theme of the Project. Styles, materials and colors will comply with the Architectural Guidelines section, herein.

FP-5 Parcel Dumpsters, Compactors, Balers

All exterior dumpsters, compactors, balers and similar appliances will be placed on well drained concrete pads and will be screened from view to passersby. Screening will consist of fences or walls with doors to cover access to the dumpster, etc. Screening will comply with the Architectural Guidelines section, herein.

FP-6 Bus Stops/Pedestrian Shelters

Bus stop and pedestrian pick-up shelters constructed on parcels will complement the Lowcountry architectural theme of adjacent buildings and the Project. Styles, materials and colors will comply with the Architectural Guidelines section, herein.

FP-7 Parcel Mail Kiosks, Mail Boxes

In some circumstances, large multi-tenant retail-commercial or office buildings may have on-site mail facilities. Parcel mail kiosks and mail boxes will complement the architectural theme of adjacent buildings and the Project. Styles, materials and colors will comply with the Architectural Guideline section, herein. The size and configuration of parcel mail kiosks and mail boxes will be determined based on the requirements of the Project and the U.S. Postal Service.









